## Michigan Care Improvement Registry (MCIR) Winter 2012

### New in MCIR

- MCIR has added a new **MCV4 (historical)** option under the **Add Immunizations** drop down vaccine list for types **No Inventory** and **Historical**. The **MCV4 (historical)** allows providers to enter a **MCV4** dose into a MCIR record when a specific vaccine brand is not known, such as when entering **Other Provider Data**. Providers should continue to choose the specific **MCV4** brand for doses provided at their office. The original historical option **Meningococcal (historical)** will not assess as a dose if chosen.

- A **Manage Inactive** link has been added to the **Manage Inventory** screen in the **Vaccine Inventory Module (VIM)**. This link provides a listing of inactive lots dated back to the when provider's VIM was activated. This link has been added as an addition to the original **Show Inactive Lots** link, which provides a limited list of lots inactivated more recently. Unlike the **Show Inactive Lots** link, the **Manage Inactive** link can sort by vaccine to narrow a search when looking for a specific vaccine lot number.

- The date a lot was added into a provider's **Vaccine Inventory Module (VIM)** has been added to the **Lot Transactions** screen as **Date Created**. This information can be useful when running reports to track lot transactions.

## Don't Forget

- Verify and update the **Responsible Party** information in MCIR records when updating information in your office records.
- Submit a **Petition for Modification** to the **Region 4 MCIR Help Desk** for name changes and corrections in MCIR. Do not create a duplicate MCIR record with the new name. Petitions are available at <http://www.gchd.us/Services/CommunityHealth/MCIR/P4Mform.pdf>.
- Contact the **Region 4 MCIR Help Desk** if unable to find a record for someone born as of **January 1, 1994 or after in Michigan** before adding a new record to MCIR. The Help Desk may be able to find the record and prevent a duplicate from being created.
- Use a person's **legal** first, middle and last name when creating a new record in MCIR (e.g. William Bradley Jones). The **Alias** field can be used to record nick names (e.g. Bill or Will) to assist in finding records in MCIR. Maiden names can also be entered under the **Alias** field.
