GCHD Announces 2009 H1N1 Flu Vaccine Clinic for Infants and Toddlers

Genesee County Health Department announces a special 2009 H1N1 Flu Vaccine appointment clinic for children 6 months through 3 years of age in Genesee County. **The appointment only clinic will give out 2009 H1N1 Nasal Spray vaccine AND the 2009 H1N1 Flu Shot.** The clinic will be held on the following 3 days:

To schedule an appointment, please call (810)-237-4546. Vaccine will be provided **ONLY** to children 6 months through 3 years of age. Nasal Spray can be given to healthy children ages 2-3 years of age at this clinic. The 2009 H1N1 vaccine is free to all. Yet, clients with health insurance **must bring their insurance information** to receive flu vaccine at no cost. This includes Medicaid, and Health Plus. Children must be accompanied by their parent or legal guardian.

Others who are interested in getting the 2009 H1N1 Flu Shot or Nasal Spray are encouraged to attend one of the McLaren Visiting Nurse sponsored School-located clinics scheduled for Genesee County.
